

After the release of their first album, La Compota took a two-year hiatus, as Erik Castillo joined **NATHY PELUSO'S BAND** and went on an international tour, traveling around the world and performing at major festivals such as Coachella in L.A., Quilmes Rock and Movistar Arena in Buenos Aires, WiZink Center and Sónar in Spain, and Ceremonia in Mexico. During this time, he played in front of thousands of people, gaining the experience and maturity needed to bring it all back to the project of his life: Compota de Manana.

During Nathy Peluso's tour, Erik and Compota de Manana continued to work and released several singles, collaborating with renowned artists such as **OPICINAL FLIAS**, **DEXANDER ABPEU**, **AND BIG LOIS**. As expected, all these productions were accompanied by music videos, produced and conceived by Erik Castillo and Aarón Barreiro, Erik's right-hand man in the audiovisual field and leader of Lecuala Films.

At the end of 2024, they released two singles, "FLVAMPIRO" and "FLCALDERO". At the beginning of 2025, they released two more singles, " | DCO DE QUÉ? and "CUESTION DE TIEMPO". The latter gives its name to the new album released this past March 12. This new work is full of high-profile collaborations. Mayito Rivera, Alexander Abreu, El Niño y La Verdad, and Telmary Díaz are just some of the names featured on "Cuestión de Tiempo". The album will include 16 new tracks, all produced and composed entirely by Compota de Manana. Erik Castillo, Manu Masaedo, and Kevin Díaz form the perfect trio to bring us once again the concept they've been working since 2018—Alternatimba in all its essence.

Not only will the musical quality and innovation in this new production surprise you, but the sound of this album is also outstanding. The final mix was done by sound giants: it was mixed in Havana by the prestigious engineer and Latin Grammy winner Orestes Águila; Javier Rae, an engineer recently nominated for a Latin Grammy and a leader of the new Latin sound in New York; Adam "Hendrix" Moralejo, the sound engineer for Eladio Carrión and winner of a Grammy Award; and mastered in Miami by one of the most prominent figures in current Latin sound, also a multiple Latin Grammy winner, Germán Landaeta.
